



CRESTED GECKO AFTER TRAVEL CARE

Hi congrats on your gecko!!

Please give your gecko at least **2 weeks to settle in** with very little handling, but make sure they are eating/drinking/pooping. Traveling, and also new environments, can be stressful to a gecko. The more time they have to explore their new environment on their own and settle in, the better they will acclimate. I have a health guarantee for 7 days after you receive the gecko. After that, I cannot guarantee their health because I am not able to monitor their environment.

It also a good idea to quarantine your gecko for about 4 weeks as a standard practice for any reptile keeper.

I have included a small amount of **Pangea Fig & Insects** - if you find the gecko is hesitant to eat in their new environment, give them the Fig & Insects. Seems to work well for hesitant eaters. If that doesn't work, try adding just a very tiny drop of honey to it.

Be sure to offer water when your gecko arrives. This is **RARE** but dehydration can sometimes occur during travel, especially if the gecko had any travel delays. If you notice your gecko not eating and also very sluggish and losing balance - rehydrate by putting them in a deli cup with a mix of a reptile electrolyte solution or human-type electrolyte drink (like Pedialyte or a reptile-specific brand) at about 75% electrolyte solution + 25% water deep enough to touch their belly. Leave the gecko in the cup supervised for 30 minutes.
